The title of the paper (in CAPS), names and affiliations of the authors (in italics) should be provided. At least one of the authors should be registered for the Conference.

For Oral Presentation- Interested candidates are requested to submit their bio-sketch and passport size scanned photograph along with the abstract. Selections will be made by the expert committee on the basis of profile and merit.

Special attraction for Master's students- exhibition of live models
Interested students are requested to meet the organising committee with their team (3-4 members) along with the theme of live model.
